JOB RESPONSIBILITIES

- Responsible for the safety, care, and well-being of all children under care.
- Responsible for the clean-up of the nursery, toys, and equipment including sink and counters. Soiled laundry to be placed in designated location.
- Responsible for keeping toys/equipment up-to-date, in safe working order and neatly organized. Report any problems immediately to the Nursery Coordinator.
- All nursery workers are to be in the nursery area and to have it ready for the children 15 minutes prior to the time of an event to begin.

There are to be a minimum of two childcare workers and/or volunteers scheduled when the nursery is open as indicated by the Safe Sanctuary policy. A minimum of three childcare workers and/or volunteers will depend upon the children's ages. Any problems, questions or information should be communicated directly to the Nursery Coordinator.

Employee's must regularly lift and/or move up to 10 pounds; frequently lift and/or move more than 50 pounds. Specific vision abilities required by this job include close vision, distance vision, color vision, depth perceptions, and the ability to adjust focus.

Reasonable accommodations may be made to enable individuals with disabilities to perform the duties and responsibilities.
